Our Emergency Department is the only Level III Trauma Center in the Lewis and Clark Valley, and our Cardiac Care services earned several designations also held only by SJRMC in the Valley. Finally, our Family Beginnings maternity service not only was named "high performing" for maternity care for the second year in a row by U.S. News and World Report, but the publication also singled out St. Joseph's as one of 83 hospitals nationwide designated as a "2024 Maternity Care Access Hospital," an inaugural designation recognizing hospitals that provide essential care in what would otherwise be "maternity care deserts."

These honors reflect our quality care as well as our desire to continuously improve as we pursue our mission of advancing your health and well-being and the well-being of the communities we serve. This report details many of the ways we give back to the Lewis and Clark Valley, ways that often extend beyond our hospital walls.
